## **A Recap of this Busy Summer:**

---

- **\$700,000 was allocated to hire new professors. The money was made available to deans in July and the high-priority seats were added before classes began.**

It has been used to hire 11 new faculty members:

College of Humanities & Social Sciences (8), University College (1), College of Science & Mathematics (1), Southern Polytechnic College of Engineering & Engineering Technology (1).

- **Kennesaw is conversing with the University System of Georgia to request formal authority to cap enrollment for the next school year.**

A cap on freshmen/transfer admissions will minimalize overcrowding and traffic on both campuses.

- **Students with “Access” and “Weekly” meal plans can swipe in guests without a limit.**

The missing 5 swipes are still around! If you did not swipe any guests in and reach 0 swipes, they will resurface for usage.

- **Kennesaw’s Sexual Misconduct Policy has been revised.**

Each party in a case can have an advisor of their choice, which includes a lawyer, and two family members at any meeting.

The fact-finder in sexual misconduct hearings is not the investigator. Pressed charges will be presented to a faculty and staff panel of 3 and they will serve as the judges in the case.

- **Faculty, staff, and students are not allowed to back into parking spots.**

Vehicles go around parking decks/lots and scan license plates to see if they are registered on campus. Backing into a spot prohibits this and will result in a ticket. If reverse parking is essential for your automobile, visit Parking & Transportation to receive a pass for that.
