Resolution adopting to improve campus pedestrian walkways for increased student mobility and safety.

WHEREAS, The overall conditions of the pedestrian walkways on the Kennesaw and Marietta campuses at Kennesaw State University are in poor condition and in need of renovations. These pose safety issues to pedestrians and creates an unfavorable environment to traverse both campuses; and

WHEREAS, The sidewalks are broken and/or breaking, which creates an unsafe walkway for pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, The crosswalks are faded and unable to be seen by pedestrians and vehicles, which creates safety issues; and

WHEREAS, There is a lack of quality and quantity of access ramps on both campuses, which limits pedestrians who have mobility impairments to cross campuses, therefore be it

RESOLVED The Student Government Association of Kennesaw State University wants to see an increased effort in the creation and annual maintenance of sidewalks on the Kennesaw and Marietta campuses by repaving current sidewalks and creating new alternative sidewalks to include gravel and mulch pathways; and be it further

RESOLVED The Student Government Association of Kennesaw State University wants to see an increased effort in the creation and annual maintenance of crosswalks on Kennesaw and Marietta campuses by repainting current sidewalks using reflective paint and installing crosswalk signs; and be it further

RESOLVED The Student Government Association of Kennesaw State University wants to see an increased effort in the repair, creation, and annual maintenance of ramps to create a culture that is conducive for mobility-impaired pedestrians.

RESOLVED that the Kennesaw State University adopts the proposed resolution for the pedestrian walkways for increased student mobility and safety.
